

The Board of Pharmacy has received notice of the following product recall. The Board strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.

NeilMed NasoGel® Drip free Spray, UPC# 705928045309

Lots# NGS751, NGS757, and NGS762

This voluntary recall has been initiated due to a microbial failure found during routine stability testing and the receipt of complaints (11 reports) related to the products' unpleasant odor.

Through investigation, this has led to the recall of 3 lots. Lots started shipping in April 2024.

Consumers should refrain from using the product from the above-mentioned lot numbers. Consuming the affected product may cause health risks in an immunocompromised user. An immunocompromised patient, with the use of contaminated nasal spray, can manifest clinical symptoms of an infection.
