The Board of Pharmacy has received notice of the following product recall. The Board strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.

Dr. Reddy's Laboratories Inc. is initiating a recall of Allopurinol Tablets USP 300 mg. This recall is initiated as a precaution due to a consumer complaint. The consumer reported that a foreign object was observed embedded in the tablet. It was concluded that foreign material was nitrile gloves used in the production area. The foreign material was clearly visible to the naked eye and chances of consuming the visible one are remote. In case of accidental ingestion of the tablets with completely embedded invisible material, it is likely to pass uneventfully in the stool. However, in case of its contact with the GI mucosa, chances of GI irritation causing nausea, vomiting, pain or in rare cases, allergic reaction to the material can be anticipated. Also the observed material being too small, and in case of ingestion of tablets with embedded invisible identified glove material, for longer period, the remote chance of its impaction in the GI tract before passing in stool cannot be ruled out completely.
