NOTIFICATION OF DISASSOCIATION AS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE-IN-CHARGE (DRIC)

Business and Professions Code section 4101(b) requires any designated representative-in-charge who ceases to act as the designated representative-in-charge of any wholesaler or veterinary food-animal drug retailer to notify the board in writing within 30 days of the date of that change in status. Failure to provide this notification to the board may result in a citation and fine or disciplinary action.
