### a. Budget Report/Update

### Fiscal Year 2017/2018 and 2018/2019

As previously reported, because of a transition to a new accounting system, FI\$CAL, final budget figures are not available for fiscal years 2017/18 and 2018/19. It was originally anticipated that such information would be available after June 2019. Regrettably this timeframe was not met and to date, the neither fiscal year 2017/18 nor fiscal year 2018/19 are final. Final budget reports for these two fiscal years will be provided when available.

### Fiscal Year 2019/2020

On June 28, 2018, the Governor signed the budget for FY 2019/20. The new budget year began July 1, 2019. The board's spending authorization for the year is \$26,007,000, which is an 11.3% increase from the prior year.

As previously noted there continues to be a delay in receiving budget information due to the problems with the FI\$CAL accounting system. Based on the preliminary reporting the board believes it has received \$13,230,600 in revenue originating from the following:







# Applications vs. Renewal FY 2019-2020 FM 5 \$12,009,600




Expenditures
