### a. Budget Update and Report

### Fiscal Year 2021/2022 (Current Year)

The 2021/22 Fiscal Year (FY) began July 1, 2021. The Board's spending authorization for the year is \$29,694,000, which is an 1.3% increase from the prior year.

### Fiscal Year 2020/2021 (Prior Year)

The prior year authorization spending was \$29,314,000. Based on current preliminary reports from May 2021, the Board received \$33,509,600 in revenue originating from the following:




  B. ASSUMES APPROPRIATION GROWTH OF 3% PER YEAR IN BY+1 AND ON-GOING..


Origin of Revenue FY 2020-2021 FM 11 \$33,509,600




# Applications vs. Renewal FY 2020-2021 FM 11 \$31,367,500
