

Board Meeting Highlights – January 8, 2025

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions at its meeting on January 8, 2025:

- Regarding the proposed regulations, California Code of Regulations, title 16, repeal of sections 1708.3, 1708.4, 1735 et seq, and 1751 et seq and addition of sections 1735 et seq, 1736 et seq, 1737 et seq, and 1738 et seq related to Compounded Drug Preparations, Hazardous Drugs, and Radiopharmaceuticals: Accepted the Board staff recommended responses to comments received during the 30-day comment period as presented; approved the recommended second modified text, as directed by the Board, for a 15-day comment period; and delegated to Members Serpa and Barker authority to review comments received with staff to offer recommendations to the Board for consideration at a future meeting.
- Regarding the proposed amendment to California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1708.2 related to Discontinuance of Business: Accepted the Board staff recommended responses to comments received during the 45-day comment period; approved modified text consistent with the Board's discussion for a 15-day comment period; and, if no adverse comments are received during the 15-day comment period, authorized the executive officer to take all steps necessary to complete the rulemaking. Further, delegated to the executive officer the authority to make technical or non-substantive changes as may be required by the control agencies to complete the rulemaking file.
- Regarding the proposed amendment to California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1711 related to Quality Assurance Programs: Accepted the Board staff recommended comment responses; approved modified text consistent with the Board's discussion for a 15-day comment period; and, if no adverse comments are received during the 15-day comment period, authorized the executive officer to take all steps necessary to complete the rulemaking. Further, delegated to the executive officer the authority to make technical or non-substantive changes as may be required by the control agencies to complete the rulemaking file.
